Procedure To Become A Member:

1. New work is juried initially by our Jury Committee and then brought to a vote by the membership. Items to be juried should be brought to the store with the completed application. Membership has 30 days in which to cast their vote.
2. Acceptability of work will be based on the quality of craftsmanship, originality, compatibility, need for a particular media, and space available. We suggest you visit the store and talk to members tending the store.
3. Prior to final membership vote, a Board of Director member will contact new applicants to schedule an interview.
4. **Upon acceptance and payment of dues**, membership will begin on the first of the month and **items will then be displayed**.
5. First three months of a new membership is probationary

A member must:

2. Work a required number of hours each month (approximately 8 hours).
3. Attend scheduled membership meetings.
4. Pay dues of \$35.00 per month plus 10% of sales and a 5% charge on credit card sales.
5. Have every item unrelated to their originally approved works re -juried and accepted by a membership vote.
6. Applicants who join after October 1 through December 31 **MUST** pay six months **non-refundable** dues in advance before their work is displayed.

BENEFITS

1. We have an excellent location at 25-27 North Broad Street in Historic Downtown Norwich.
2. Members set their own prices and retain 90% of each sale.
3. MIC pays all sales taxes and members receive his/her receipts and check for that month at the beginning of the next month.
4. Participation in a cooperatively run business in which each member is an owner/operator having an equal vote in decisions made concerning the operations of MIC.
5. Members have a voice in display, advertising and merchandising of their own work.
6. Member's works will be displayed and featured in our windows.
7. Direct contact with the buying public and camaraderie with fellow artists and craft
